ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECLARED that Judgment be and the same is hereby entered in favor Plaintiff Mitch Geier and against the Defendant New Egypt Main Street as follows:

1. Defendant New Egypt Main Street, is declared to be a Public Body as defined in NJSA 10:4-8(a) and as such is Declared to

be subject to the Open Public Meetings Act NJSA 10:4-6 et. seq. and the Open Public Records Act NJSA 47:1A-1 et. seq.

2. Defendant New Egypt Main Street, by its officers, administrators, and Executive Director, is hereby Ordered to supply to Plaintiff, within ten days of receipt of this Judgment, the minutes of meetings of the Defendant New Egypt Main Street as follow:

- A. November and December 2001,
- B. February, April and September, 2002,
- C. January, February, March, April, July and August 2003,
- D. February, March, April, September, October, November and December 2004
- E. All Executive Board meetings whether "closed" or not

3. Defendant New Egypt Main Street, by its officers, administrators, and Executive Director, is hereby Ordered to supply to Plaintiff, within ten days of receipt of this Order, the name and address of all banking institutions used by the defendant or in which the defendant maintained any form of account, the name and address of the current custodian of the banking records of the defendant since the defendant was created or otherwise organized, copies of the bank statements of the Defendant, copies of deposit tickets for all deposits, the identification of the source of all deposits made into any

account of the Defendant, copies of all checks issued by the defendant, copies the check-book stubs for any checks issued by defendant.

4. That the Clerk of this Court tax fees and costs in favor of the Plaintiff Mitch Geier and against the Defendant NEW EGYPT MAIN STREET.
5. That Plaintiff's counsel serve a copy of this Judgment upon the Defendant within ten days of receipt of the Judgment.
